RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION

Recruiting/Retention efforts are going pretty well. We have good retention from both middle schools, especially considering the current state of band and the lack of connection we have had.. The numbers we started with were smaller, so our numbers are hitting right around 45 students with 5-6 taking a Jazz offering too. Freshman retention is looking a bit sketchy, but I am still working on about 6 students that I believe just need to hit the "reset" button and try a real HS band program next fall. Overall, numbers will still be right around 145-150 students in the program for next year. We have lost several students over the course of the year. I don't know if any of those

students will return like they said they would. If any of those students return, that would bump the numbers higher. We started in Fall of 2020 with 156 before the first day of school. We are currently at 140.

Overall I am very pleased that we have maintained our numbers in this climate. KUDOS go to our wonderful students and their families. Also to our 2 amazing middle school band directors. I also felt that the FOCB outreach last week was awesome! Thank you to everyone in FOCB that assisted in making that happen.

Now have forecasting sheets for incoming frosh, about 46 kids. Now working on current frohs, rising sophs. TOay about 145 students for fall. Will grow a little more at beginning of year, and maybe ones that dropped this year. Will maintain numbers despite pandemic.
